Open Show Awards Program



The purpose of the Open Show Awards Program is to recognize CVPHC members who compete in local open and 4-H horse shows with a registered American Paint Horse.

- Participant must be a member in good standing with CVPHC. If an individual is not a current member of CVPHC and would like for his/her points to count towards year-end awards, membership to CVPHC must be postmarked and submitted within 30 business days before the date of the open show.
- Horse must be a registered American Paint Horse. Breeding Stocks or Solid Paint Breed's are welcome.
- Points/placing are per horse/rider team.
- Must compete in a minimum of five (5) approved open shows between January 1 and November 30 in Virginia, N.C., S.C, WVA, MD and PA.
- Must accumulate a minimum of 15 points to be counted towards any division award.
- Any show open to horses of all breeds and all colors in the surrounding states of S.C., N.C., WVA, MD and PA can be used for this program.
- Youth participants must be 18 years of age or under as of January 1st of the current year, as specified in APHA Rule Book GR020 I & J.
- Six places will count for points. This follows the PAC point system referenced on the CVPHC Exhibitor Form. The Central Virginia Paint Horse Club uses the following credit system.

9. Dressage Points are as follows:

Intro Training 1st and 2nd Levels

This system is used regardless of the number of entries and the horse must receive a score of at least 55%	
<i>67.001% or Better</i>	<i>4 Credits</i>
<i>64.001% - 67.000%</i>	<i>3 Credits</i>
<i>60.001% - 64.000%</i>	<i>2 Credits</i>
<i>55.000% - 60.000%</i>	<i>1 Credits</i>

Third and fourth levels

This system is used regardless of the number of entries and the horse must receive a score of at least 50%	
<i>65.000% - or Better</i>	<i>5 Credits</i>
<i>60.001% - 65.000%</i>	<i>4 Credits</i>
<i>60.001% - 64.000%</i>	<i>3 Credits</i>
<i>50.000% - 55.000%</i>	<i>2 Credits</i>

10. Participants must complete an official Open Show Awards Program point reporting form. This form must contain the signature of the exhibitor and the authorized signature of the open show Secretary (**exhibitor and show secretary cannot be the same**).
11. Any discrepancies between the information submitted and that of the respective organizations will be resolved in favor of the organization's authority.
12. Point Reporting Forms must be received within 30 days of the Open Show date.
13. The final Point Reporting Form for the year must be received (in hand, not postmarked by) no later than November 30th.

Divisions

1. Youth Halter/Showmanship – Eligible classes: Halter, Showmanship at Halter
2. Adult Halter/Showmanship - Eligible classes: Halter, Showmanship at Halter
3. Youth Western Performance – Eligible classes: Western Pleasure, Go-As-You-Please
4. Adult Western Performance – Eligible classes: Western Pleasure, Go-As-You-Please
5. Youth Hunt Seat Performance – Eligible classes: Hunter Under Saddle, Go-As-You-Please
6. Adult Hunt Seat Performance – Eligible classes: Hunter Under Saddle, Go-As-You-Please
7. Dressage – Eligible classes: Intro A & B
8. Dressage – Eligible classes: Training, thru Fourth Level
9. Small Fry Western Performance 11 and under – Eligible classes: Walk/Jog, Go-As-You-Please, Western Showmanship

CVPHC will award prizes to Reserve and Champion places in each division at the annual Year-End Banquet. Those divisions will be Youth Division, Adult Division and Small Fry.
