A note from the Jerry Slemp Benefit Show Series Committee:

On December 12, 2009 Jerry Slemp, AQHA Professional Horseman and trainer, was riding a quiet training horse when he had a terrible accident. The horse fell on Jerry and dislocated his neck. They are not sure what happened and Jerry does not remember.

He was rushed to UVA hospital in Charlottesville. Jerry had dislocated his neck and crushed his C6 vertebrae. They immediately put him into traction and after two days the doctors were able to operate to replace the crushed vertebrae and insert cadaver bone, plates and screws as well as fuse the neck from the C5 to C7 vertebrae.

Jerry is home and doing rehabilitation and it is not clear yet whether he will ever be able to ride again. Hopefully with time and healing he will eventually be able to give lessons and judge horse shows. He is considered disabled at this time.

Needless to say training horses is Jerry's passion and he lived the past decade doing what he loved and he, along with his wife Julie, have been very successful in both the Quarter Horse and Paint Horse communities and beyond. Most of his clients have gone on to win numerous Championships and Futurities both at the breed show level and on the local show circuit. But as with most horse trainers, training horses was Jerry's only source of income.

The medical bills continue to grow and will continue for some time. A group of his friends, colleagues and clients have come together to plan this benefit show series to financially help the Slempts.

Class Descriptions

Open Showmanship: All Age Horses and Handlers are judged on execution of pattern and appearance of both. Class can be split at judge's decision.

Open Halter: All Horses are judged on confirmation and movement. Class can be split at judge's decision.

Leadline: Open to riders 7 years old and younger. English or Western Exhibitors will be asked to perform simple task with aid from adult leading their horse/pony. Spotters are allowed.

Pee-Wee Walk: Open to riders 10 & younger. English or Western Riders are judged at a walk and asked to perform simple task (i.e. halt, reverse, line-up). Spotters allowed. Riders who exhibit in this class are not allowed to cross enter into other classes that ask for trot/canter.

12 & Under (Hunter Under Saddle/Western): Open to riders 12 & younger as of 1 January, 2010. Riders must wear appropriate attire for selected discipline. Riders will be asked to show at the walk and trot/jog both directions. Riders who exhibit in these classes are not allowed to cross enter into other classes that ask for a canter.

Youth (Hunter Under Saddle/Western): Open to riders 17 & younger as of 1 January, 2010. Riders must wear appropriate attire for selected discipline. Riders will be asked to show at the walk/trot/canter and/or walk/jog/lope as appropriate in selected discipline in both directions.

Adult (Hunter Under Saddle/Western): Open to riders 18 & over as of 1 January, 2010. Riders must wear appropriate attire for selected discipline. Riders will be asked to show at the walk/trot/canter and/or walk/jog/lope as appropriate in selected discipline in both directions.

Jr. Horse (Hunter Under Saddle/Western): Open to horses 5 years of age or under as of 1 January, 2010. Horses must be shown in the appropriate tack for selected discipline as set by AQHA and APHA regulations. Horses will be asked to show at the walk/trot/canter and/or walk/jog/lope as appropriate in selected discipline in both directions.

Sr. Horse (Hunter Under Saddle/Western): Open to horses 6 years of age or over as of 1 January, 2010. Horses must be shown in the appropriate tack for selected discipline as set by AQHA and APHA regulations. Horses will be asked to show at the walk/trot/canter and/or walk/jog/lope as appropriate in selected discipline in both directions. Sr horses cannot be show in a snaffle bit or bosal in WP.

Open Trail: Open to all ages' horses and riders. Walk/Trot version: Exhibitors will only be asked to walk or trot/jog to, from, or over obstacles (more beginner rider and horse friendly). Walk/Trot/Canter: Exhibitors will be asked to walk, trot/jog, or canter/lope to, from, or over obstacles (intermediate/advance course). Both are judged on execution of pattern.

Plug Barrel Class: Walk/Trot version: Exhibitors will only be asked to walk or trot/jog around barrel (more beginner rider and horse friendly). There are time penalties for breaking in anything faster than a trot. Open Version: Exhibitors can go as they please around said barrel (intermediate/advance course). Both are judged on time.

Barrel Class: Walk/Trot version: Exhibitors will only be asked to walk or trot/jog around barrels (more beginner rider and horse friendly) in the correct pattern. There are time penalties for breaking in anything faster than a trot. Open Version: Exhibitors can go as they please around said barrels (intermediate/advance course) in the correct pattern. Both are judged on time.

Pole Bending Class: Timed event. The course consists of a series of six poles spaced 21 feet apart, which horses and riders weave through. Horses run to the far end of the series of poles, turn, and weave in and out as they work their way back to the front. Horses then complete a turn around the front pole and maneuver through the series again. At the last pole, they complete that turn and race toward the finish line at full speed. A five-second penalty is added for each pole knocked down

Show Rules

1. The judge's decision is final.
2. Placing to sixth place, ribbons to fourth place. Champion will be awarded in each Division after both shows are held.
3. Current negative coggins is required for all horses brought onto show grounds.
4. Exhibitors ride at their own risk. Mica Springs Farm, Silver Star Farm, their employees & associates and show series committee members will not be held responsible for any loss, accident or injury during this horse show.
5. All youth exhibitors must wear helmets at all times while mounted.
6. Shows will follow all AQHA/APHA class regulations/rules.
7. Youth participants must have parent/legal guardian sign waiver.
8. Youth exhibitor – 17 or younger (as of Jan 1, 2010)
9. Adult exhibitor – 18 years or older (as of Jan 1, 2010)
10. \$30.00 fee for all returned checks
11. All dogs MUST be on a least at ALL TIMES.
